**(I). Prevention of Money Laundering**

(Edited by Dr. K.N. Chandrasekharan Pillai, Director, Indian Law Institute and Dr. A. Francis Julian, Sr. Advocate, Supreme Court of India.)

Money laundering is a crime of recent origin. Its social, political and economic implications are far and wide. For the criminal justice administration system, money laundering assumes a lot of importance in as much as the global crimes such as drug trafficking, terrorism etc. thrive on money laundering. Money laundering on a large scale could result in economic and political instability in a country. Realising such potential of the offence the international community has initiated several measures with a view to curbing it. With a view to creating awareness and to alert the officers responsible for the prevention of money laundering, government of India arranged a seminar at the Indian Law Institute in 2005. Several issues concerning this were deliberated upon. The book contains some of the papers presented in this seminar. While the international dimensions of anti money laundering measures are captured by *Dr. Francis Julian, Professor Pillai* tries to evaluate the efficacy of the Indian legislation. The role of the banks and the technological aspects of money laundering are examined in depth in the book. All the documents on prevention of money laundering such as the enactment, rules and the notifications issued by the Govt. of India have been put in the appendix making it a self-contained comprehensive work.

(V) **Services under the State (Revised and updated)**

This prestigious publication of the Indian Law Institute has its genesis in the original book written by the illustrious author Justice Rama Jois, former Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana High Court. Later it came to be updated and ably edited by another illustrious authority, Prof. Upendra Baxi, the then Research Director of the ILI and former Vice-Chancellor of South Gujarat University and Delhi University. When all the copies of Second Edition had been sold out, the book has been revised and updated by the Research Faculty members of ILI. The book provides an overall understanding of civil services law and civil services jurisprudence. It is an authoritative exposition of adjudicative law as well as a critique of it, helping its future renovation.
